**"TDM PRIHATIN" EASED COMMUNITY'S BURDEN**

The implementation of such programme can indirectly encourage and nurture the value of unity, teamwork, and toleration amongst the community".

Each activity was carried out in accordance with the standard operating procedures (SOP) of the Recovery Movement Control Order (RMCO) and the guidelines by the Ministry of Health Malaysia (MoF).

In the same event, TDM also donated cash and basic necessities to 61 selected families to help alleviate their burdens and livelihoods. The donation was presented by YB Mohd Nor bin Hamzah after the closing speech of the program.
