## **TDM RESERVES 514 HECTARES OF LAND TO ENSURE THE SUCCESS OF THE NESTLÉ MALAYSIA RELeaf PROGRAMME**

**KUALA TERENGGANU** – TDM Plantation Sdn Bhd ("TDMP"), the plantation division of TDM Berhad ("TDM" or the "Group"), joined hands with Nestlé Malaysia in an effort to uphold the sustainability of the earth with a reserve of 514 hectares of land to plant 350,000 trees to enable the goal of Nestlé's RELeaf Project towards 3 million trees planted throughout Malaysia by early 2025.

The replanting of 2,000 trees for the state of Terengganu at TDMP Jernih Estate, Kemaman, Nestlé Malaysia has achieved its goal of planting one million trees. The Nestlé Cares Nationwide Tree Planting programme was carried out concurrently in five locations, with the participation of 450 volunteers from TDM Plantation, Nestlé, and Sime Darby Plantation (SDP), namely at TDMP Jernih Estate in Terengganu, SDP Carey Island Estate in Selangor, SDP Gunung Mas Estate in Johor, SDP Tenom Estate in Sabah, and Hutan Simpan Bukit Bintang in Perlis. Present to launch the programme was YB Che Alias Hamid, Director of TDMP, accompanied by Encik Hamdan Ibrahim, Chief Executive Officer of TDMP, and Juan Aranols, Chief Executive Officer of Nestlé Malaysia.

Hamdan Ibrahim, Chief Executive Officer of TDMP, said, "We at TDM are very pleased to be working with Nestlé Malaysia, a giant company with great influence. The act of replanting 2,000 trees will not only contribute to the reforestation of this area but also help fight climate change by absorbing carbon dioxide and releasing oxygen. These trees will be living proof of our commitment to sustainability and, more importantly, will serve as habitats for various species of flora and fauna while supporting biodiversity in the region. This collaboration will simultaneously open the eyes of more parties to participate in our efforts to green the earth for a better future."

TDM's participation in Nestlé Malaysia's Project RELeaf initiative is part of the company's corporate social responsibility (CSR), which is highly important, especially in terms of fulfilling the objective of saving the environment through tree planting activities that can have a good
