TDM GO GREEN: BACK TO SCHOOL AND RECYCLING AWARENESS

Kuala Terengganu, 1st February 2026 –TDM Berhad ("TDM" or the "Group"), organised the "TDM Go Green: Back to School & Recycling Awareness" programme at Sekolah Kebangsaan Padang Kubu (SK Padang Kubu), Kemaman as part of its Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) initiatives to support educational development and foster environmental awareness among primary school students. The programme involved the participation of 300 students from Year 1 to Year 6, together with TDM employees and teachers of SK Padang Kubu, Kemaman. It aimed to provide early exposure to the importance of recycling practices, responsible waste management and the cultivation of discipline and environmental stewardship. Throughout the programme, students took part in interactive sharing sessions on the importance of maintaining environmental cleanliness, as well as practical hands-on recycling activities to enhance their understanding of waste segregation and proper recycling practices.

As a result of the waste collection and segregation activities carried out, a total of 153 kilograms of waste materials were successfully collected, comprising paper, plastic and metal or glass waste, reflecting the effectiveness of a hands-on learning approach in fostering environmental awareness among students. The programme was further enhanced with the distribution of school bags and stationery to prepare students for the upcoming new school term.

Haji Najman Kamaruddin, Group Chief Executive Officer of TDM, said, "The organisation of this programme reflects the Group's continued commitment within the communities where we operate to support the environmental sustainability agenda and quality education, in line with the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), particularly SDG 4: Quality Education and SDG 12: Responsible Consumption and Production.
