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TDM ADVANCES ESG AGENDA THROUGH PROGRAM RELIFE

Kuala Terengganu, 9th June 2026 –TDM Berhad ("TDM" or the "Group") continues to strengthen its commitment to environmental sustainability through the organisation of Program RELife 2026, held at Pelung Estate, Sungai Tong. The programme forms part of the Group's ongoing efforts to advance its Environmental, Social and Governance (ESG) agenda through environmental conservation initiatives that deliver long-term impact on communities, biodiversity and climate resilience.

The programme was attended by Haji Najman Kamaruddin, Group Chief Executive Officer of TDM, Encik Hamdan Ibrahim, Chief Executive Officer of TDM Plantation Sdn Bhd and Encik Wan Ghazali Wan Ali, Assistant Director (Recreational Forest) of Terengganu State Forestry Department.

As a manifestation of its collective commitment to environmental stewardship, a total of 200 saplings of Mentalun and Kekatung sponsored by Nestlé Malaysia were planted during the programme. Tree planting plays a critical role not only in enhancing green cover, but also as a natural mechanism for carbon sequestration, mitigating climate change and strengthening ecosystem balance. Beyond restoring green areas, the initiative contributes to biodiversity enhancement, preservation of natural habitats and improved environmental resilience for future generations.

Based on current studies and estimates, each mature tree is capable of absorbing approximately 10 to 22 kilograms of carbon dioxide annually, depending on species and environmental conditions. As such, the 200 trees planted under this programme are expected to collectively absorb between two to 4.4 tonnes of carbon dioxide per year upon maturity, contributing to carbon footprint reduction and broader climate targets.

Commenting on the initiative, Haji Najman Kamaruddin said the programme reflects TDM's long-term commitment to embedding sustainability as a core pillar of its business strategy and operations.

"At TDM, we believe that the success of an organisation is not measured solely by financial performance, but also by the value it creates for society and the environment. Program RELife serves as a key platform for translating our ESG commitments into tangible actions with lasting impact. It is part of our strategic approach to integrate ESG principles holistically across our business and operational activities, in line with our aspiration to be a responsible, resilient and value-driven organisation for all stakeholders."

In addition to its environmental benefits, the initiative also supports the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (UNSDGs), particularly SDG 13: Climate Action and SDG 15: Life on Land, which emphasise the urgency of addressing climate change and protecting terrestrial ecosystems.

As a key player in both the plantation and healthcare sectors, TDM will continue to expand high-impact programmes that support its ESG agenda, strengthen environmental conservation efforts and enhance community well-being.
